

Квітня Неділя

Сьогодні Квітня Неділя. Ми святкуємо Вхід Господній у Єрусалим. Весь народ вітав Христа словами: "Осанна, благословен, хто йде в ім'я Господнє." Люди стелили свої одежі, діти кидали пальмове віття на дорогу, по якій ступав Христос. Всі вітали Ісуса як Царя, Месію, який визволить Ізраїльський народ від римських окупантів. На згадку про цю Євангельську подію ми благословимо вербні галузки і несемо їх до наших осель, як символ того, що Христос і для нас є Царем, але як сам говорив: "Царство моє не від цього світу" (Ів. 18: 36). Христове Царство є Царством любові, милосердя, прощення, а всі ми у тому Царстві не є рабами, але вільними, люблячими синами і дочками, і успадковуємо це Царство не тому, що ми Христа полюбили, а навпаки, тому, що Він нас перший полюбив.



Palm Sunday

Today's feast celebrates the arrival of Jesus at His final destination: Jerusalem. As He entered the city, He was met by the people bearing palm branches in their hands and acclaiming Him as the King of Israel, who comes in the name of the Lord.

As we celebrate Palm Sunday, we are summoned to behold our King. We are called to behold and acclaim Jesus as our King not only as the one who comes to us riding on a colt on this particular day. But as the one who comes to us in power and glory unceasingly, in every Divine Liturgy, as we receive the Holy Eucharist; in every Sacrament that we receive; in every act of love and mercy that we perform; in every moment that we become aware of His presence and recognize Him as our King and God.

Palm Sunday calls us to behold our King – the Suffering Servant – who comes to Jerusalem to suffer and die on the cross for our sins and who invites us to pick up our crosses daily and follow Him.

Palm Sunday calls us to behold our King and accept His Kingdom, the Kingdom of God. This Kingdom is a present reality that we are called to be aware of and to make the goal and content of our Christian life.

As we celebrate the triumphal entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem and behold and acclaim Him as our King, we take home with us a branch of pussy willow. May it be for us a reminder that Jesus comes to us in the name of the Lord unceasingly, and let us be aware of His constant presence in our life.



Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Matthew 26:14-27:66

Just prior to this week's Passion narrative in St. Matthew's Gospel, there is a small, striking story describing a woman's scandalous action toward Jesus: "A woman came up to him with an alabaster jar of costly perfumed oil, and poured it on his head" (Matthew 26:7). The ointment was pure nard, worth more than 300 denarii. A year's wages. Maybe a dowry, maybe a family inheritance. In any case, she breaks it. She does not measure or ration. She pours it all out, irreversibly, over Jesus. Why does this image begin Holy Week?

Because what she does with the jar, Jesus will soon do with his life. The jar must be broken so the fragrance can be released. Jesus' body will be broken so his priceless divine and human love can be poured out. She gives everything, just as he is about to give everything. And He sees it: "She has done a good thing for me" (Matthew 26:10). Her act is lavish, impractical, scandalous in its apparent wastefulness. And he loves it. It is what Holy Week is all about.

What jar are you still holding onto? Your time? Your comfort? Your plan for how life should go? Don't just wave palms today. Let yourself be broken open so your love, too, can be poured out.

Lenten Challenge: Offer something costly to Jesus this Holy Week — not out of guilt, but love. Your attention. Your forgiveness. Your time. Break the jar. Trust that nothing poured out for him is ever wasted
